1. The final entry list order is based on the starting number of all the drivers accepted for the race.
2. The participation of competitors in the race is subject to compliance with the rules of the International Sporting Code, the FIA European Autocross and Cross Car Sporting Regulations, and the event's Supplementary Regulations, as well as the submission of the required documentation during the administrative check.
3. The maximum number of starters in the Event, including the support race, shall not exceed 140, and the maximum number of entries per category shall not exceed 40. Where the maximum number of entries for one or more categories has been reached, but the overall Event entry limit has not yet been met, additional entries may be accepted in those categories, provided that the criteria set out in Article 7.1.5 of the Sporting Regulations are respected. This provision shall remain applicable until the overall maximum number of entries permitted for the Event has been reached (Article 7.3.4 of the Sporting Regulations).
4. Acceptance of entries shall be decided by each organiser; however, priority shall be applied by category, and entries shall be selected and validated in accordance with the order of priorities listed in Article 7.1.5 of the Sporting Regulations.
5. The Organising Committee reserves the right to refuse the entry of a Competitor or a Driver, stating the reasons for such refusal, and in accordance with the priorities specified in Article 7.1.5 of the Sporting Regulations (Article 7.3.1 of the Sporting Regulations).
